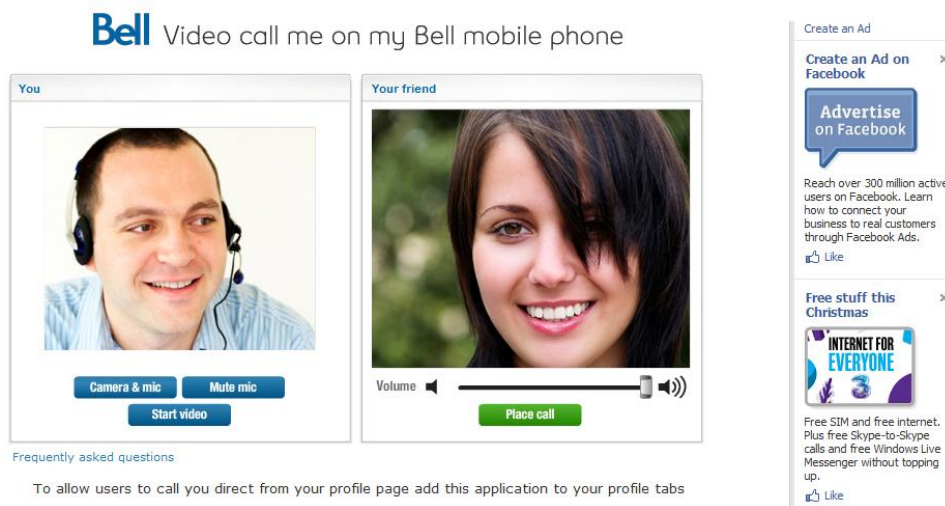
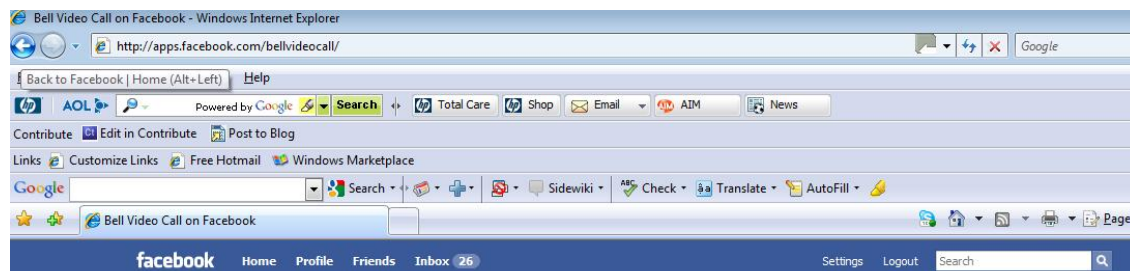


# UK company, REQUESTEC, Provides Canada's Bell Mobility with unique 3G Mobile Video Calling Application for Facebook

## Requestec builds Bell Mobility's *Bell Video Call* on Facebook Platform

LONDON, UK: Requestec Ltd – the World's leading Adobe™ Flash-to-SIP telephony provider – today announced their key involvement in the release of Bell Mobility's, 'Bell Video Call' application built on the Facebook Platform.



"We were approached by Bell Mobility about the possibility of incorporating video-calling functionality into Facebook," says Requestec's CEO, Marek Zwiefka-Sibley. "This was our chance to show the world our technology within the Internet's leading online community, Facebook."

The application allows Facebook users to visit the profile page of a Bell Mobility subscriber that has added the application and click on their *Bell Video Call* tab. From here, calls can be made from anywhere in the world to the Bell Mobility subscriber's HSPA Video Calling handset; all at no cost to the caller.

Ben Weekes, Requestec's Head of Technology, said of the partnership: "Working with Bell Mobility was an invigorating experience. They challenged us to deliver our best possible results through diligent planning, attention to detail and impressive organisation. We're proud of our involvement in the venture, and proud too of satisfying Bell's expectations within a relatively short period of time."

The Facebook application is the latest in a long line of technological innovations from Requestec. In 2008, the company launched Voixio, one of the world's first web-based no-download Flash-to-SIP telephony services, featuring multi-party video conferencing, visual mail, call diverts and more. It is this forward-thinking approach to new technology that prompted Bell Mobility to approach Requestec and there are more developments in the pipeline.

The Bell Mobility Video Call application is available exclusively to Bell Mobility subscribers with video calling capable phones on the new HSPA network and is the first video calling application in North America that is fully integrated into Facebook. Offering mobile speeds as high as 21 Megabits per second (21 Mbps), the new HSPA network launched by Bell last month covers 1.2 million square kilometres, reaching approximately 20,000 Canadian towns and cities and 93% of the population.
